METRO

One of the best ways to travel through Madrid is the Metro which is a rail system. It operates every day from 6:00 AM until 1:30 AM and the trains pass every few minutes, so it is quite a quick way to get everywhere in Madrid. There is a **Metro Map** which we highly recommend you to download:

2. WHERE IS MY ACCOMODATION?

Metro Station: Antón Martín Line 1 (Light Blue), 2 minutes walking from the metro station




Metro station: **Sol** is also close to the accommodation. It takes about 7 minutes walking to reach it and there you can take three metro lines (*Line 1, Line 2, Line 3*) and two *Cercanías Lines* (C3, C4).









CHECK-IN: Friday, March 16th after 13:00h

CHECK-OUT: Saturday, March 24th before 10:30h







3. HOW DO I GET TO THE ACCOMMODATION?

FROM THE AIRPORT:

Option 1 - Metro:



Take the metro in any airport terminal, Line 8 to *Nuevos Ministerios*. In *Nuevos Ministerios* change to Line 10 (Navy Blue) to *Tribunal* station and there change again to Line 1 (Light Blue) to *Antón Martín*.

Metro is the easiest way to reach the hostel from any airport terminal.

Option 2:

Cercanías train / Airport Bus to Atocha

You can choose between *Cercanías* train (C1) or Airport Bus. Both of them will take you to **Atocha** Station. Just keep in mind that C1 *Cercanías* Line only sets off from Terminal 4 of the airport. If you arrive at a different terminal, you have to take a free bus from T1/T2/T3 to T4, outside any terminal.

From Atocha Station to the accommodation


From **Atocha** Station there are about 15 minutes walking to the hostels, through *Atocha Street,* getting *Anton Martín Square*. You can find a map on the next page.

Alternatively you can take buses 6, 26 or 32 to get there or metro Line 1 from **Atocha** to **Antón Martín**.









FROM MÉNDEZ ÁLVARO MAIN BUS STATION:

The bus station has its own *Metro* Station inside, called **Méndez Álvaro** as well. Take the Metro there, *Line 6* (Grey) to **Pacífico** (1 stop). There change to **Line 1** (**Light Blue**) to **Antón Martín**.

Friday, March 16th - Welcome Party

The party will take place at Sala Mitty (Calle Julián Romea, 4, 28003 Madrid)

Meeting point 23:00h at Guzmán el Bueno metro station (Line 6 and Line 7)

<u>One drink ticket is provided</u> by BEST-UPM students. You must show your ID-Card with a picture to the BEST-UPM students that will be at the pub entrance **BEFORE 00:00h**.

IMPORTANT:

- Make sure you <u>bring your ID</u> (with a picture), your passport or similar along with you. We need to identify you.
- Come quite smartly dressed. If you're not, you might not get admitted by the staff.
- BEFORE 00:00h!



How to reach the meeting point: To go from the accommodation, the best way is to take the metro **line 1** in *Antón Martín* to *Cuatro Caminos* and there take metro **line 6** to *Guzmán el Bueno.*



Going back to the accommodation:

- **Before 1:30h**: you can take the metro back to the accommodations.
- After 1:30h: If you stay longer (as we hope you will), you have other options:
 - The city has an efficient network of night transport that works during all night so you
 can come back to the hostel by bus whenever you want. You can go in 'búho' (owl)
 buses that end and begin their line at Cibeles Square and their frequency depends on
 the day of the week, being around 40 minutes from Sunday to








Thursday and 20 minutes in Friday and Saturday nights.

You'll have to take the **N21** at San Fco. de Sales - Guzman el Bueno towards Plaza de Cibeles (11 stops) and there take **N26** towards Aluche and get off the bus at the sation of Antón Martín (4 stops). You can go walking from Plaza de Cibeles to the hostel (15 minutes approx.). (Map below).

You can take different buses depending on the hour; we would recommend you to check the best alternative on <u>Google maps</u>.

• You may also take a **taxi**. There are many taxis in Madrid and they are not particularly expensive, especially if you are not alone, and you will be not.









Saturday, March 17th - Registration & Official Opening / Reina Sofia Museum



How to reach the meeting point...

From the airport:

Do take the metro in the airport, any terminal, Line 8 to Nuevos Ministerios (7 stops). There, take metro Line 6 to Metropolitano (4 stops).

From the accomodation:

Take the metro in Antón Martín, Line 1, to Cuatro Caminos. There, take the metro again, Line 6, to Metropolitano. (about 35 minutes)

In Metropolitano station, take the exit Juan XXIII, and follow the map.

- Don't forget to bring your <u>student's card</u> with you!








Sunday, March 18th - Prado museum/ City Rally


After lunch you will have some free time. We would recommend you to spend some time visiting *Retiro Park*

There will be different Meeting Points (you will find out how to get below), where some BEST-UPM student will be waiting for you on Monday to walk you to the different lecture rooms.

From the accommodation to ETSI Diseño Industrial:

Take the Metro in the station *Sol*, Line 3 to *Embajadores* and walk for about 2 minutes.

The whole journey will take about 15 minutes.









From the accommodation to ETSI Sistemas de Telecomunicación:

Take the Metro in the station *Antón Martín*, Line 1 to *Sierra de Guadalupe* and walk for about 13 minutes.


The whole journey will take about 40 minutes.



From the accommodation to INEF:

Take the Metro in the station *Antón Martín*, **Line 1** to *Sierra de Guadalupe*. In *Cuatro Caminos* change to **Line 6** to *Ciudad Universitaria* and walk for about 11 minutes.

The whole journey will take about 40 minutes.



From the accommodation to ETSI Arquitectura:

Take the Metro in the station *Antón Martín*, Line 1 to *Cuatro Caminos*. In *Cuatro Caminos* change to Line 6 to *Ciudad Universitaria* and walk for about 10 minutes.

The whole journey will take about 36 minutes.

From the accommodation to ETSI Agronómica, A y B:

Take the Metro in the station *Antón Martín*, **Line 1** to *Cuatro Caminos*. In *Cuatro Caminos* change to **Line 6** to *Ciudad Universitaria* and walk for about 15 minutes.

The whole journey will take about 40 minutes.







Wednesday, March 21st: Night Walk

The purpose of the Night Walk is to show you some of the most emblematic places of the city at night. It will take up an hour and a half approx. then we will take you to some pubs to grab some drinks and party for a while.

Meeting point

21:00h at **SOI**, near to the statue of "el Oso y el Madroño" (as you can see in the map, it's located in front of the entrance to SoI from Alcalá street)



From the accommodation:

The meeting point is quite close to the accommodation; we would recommend you to go walking.

The party will take place at a place called **Bolshoi** (Av. de Brasil, 3b, 28020 Madrid)

Meeting point 23:00h at Estrecho metro station (Line 1)

<u>One drink ticket is provided</u> by BEST-UPM students. You must show your ID-Card with a picture to the BEST-UPM students that will be at the pub entrance **BEFORE 00:00h**.

IMPORTANT:

- Make sure you bring your ID (with a picture), your passport or similar along with you. We need to identify you.
- Come quite smartly dressed. If you're not, you might not get admitted by the staff.
- BEFORE 00:00h!



How to reach the meeting point: To go from the accommodation, the best way is to take the metro line 1 in *Antón Martín* to *Estrecho* station.



Going back to the accommodation:

- **Before 1:30h**: you can take the metro back to the accommodations.
- After 1:30h: If you stay longer (as we hope you will), you have other options:
 - You'll have to take the N22 (12 stops to Cibeles) or N24 (10stops to Cibeles) at Lima-Santiago Bernabeu towards Plaza de Cibeles. Once you get there you can take the N26 towards Aluche and get off at the station of Anton Martín (4 stops) or you can go walking from Plaza de Cibeles to the hostel (15 minutes approx.). (Map below). You can take different buses depending on the hour; we would recommend you to


