Location: E.T.S.I. Agronómica. Campus Ciudad Universitaria.

Course and distribution:

- 50 hours of face to face teaching, consisting of 24, 2hour sessions plus a final exam.

Evaluation: continuous evaluation, including a portfolio, oral presentations (according to the group level) and a final exam

Certification:
