3. European Health Card or a document stating that you are in possession of health insurance
4. Transcript of records
5. A Statement of Purpose in either Spanish or English in which the candidate sets out his or her reasons for wishing to study at the UPM, together with a list of the subjects that he or she wishes to study.
6. Curriculum vitae
7. Research project description and agreement signed by the student and the UPM advisor.

ENROLLMENT

The enrollment process will be carried out in the student admissions office, with the assistance of the International Office of the School or Faculty in which the student has applied for the position.

REQUIREMENTS FOR ENTRY TO SPANISH TERRITORY

A foreigner is defined as someone not holding Spanish nationality.

Nationals of the Member States of the European Union do not need a visa to study in Spain. However, students from any other country in the world or those who are not sure about visa status should consult the Spanish Embassy/Consulate in their country of residence.

Personal data collected in the registration process shall be included and processed in the file called "*Gestión Académica*" and will serve only for academic and administrative purposes that are applicable. Any other use will be contrary to that specified in the Constitutional Law LO 15/1999, of 13th December, on the Protection of Personal Data. The body responsible for it is the *Secretaría General* of *Universidad Politécnica de Madrid*, where the interested party will be able to exert their right to access, rectify, cancel and oppose, all the above information which has been provided in compliance with article 5 of Organic Law 15/1999, of 13 December, on Personal Data Protection.
